
Tuesday North has now resumed its Open Speaker format on the last Tuesday of each month, whether there is a Birthday celebration occurring or not.

April 7, 1941: Ruth Hock reported there were 1,500 letters asking for help, as a result of the <u>Saturday</u> <u>Evening Post Article by Jack Alexander</u>.

April 10, 1939: The first ten copies of the Big Book arrived at the office Bill shared with <u>Hank Parkhurst</u> in Newark, New Jersey.

April 12, 1942: The Windsor Daily Star in Ontario, Canada, reported that over 400 AA's attended a testimonial dinner for Dr. Bob.

April 16, 1940: A sober <u>Rollie Hemsley</u> caught the only opening day no-hitter in baseball history since 1909.

April 25, 1951: AA's first <u>General Service</u> <u>Conference</u> was held.

April 30, 1989: The film "<u>My Name is Bill W.,</u>" a Hallmark Hall of Fame presentation, was broadcast on ABC TV.

1940: The <u>first AA pamphlet was published</u>, entitled simply: "AA."
