Service opportunities can help keep us sober, introduce us to more AA members and help carry the message.



Alcoholics Anonymous Through The Years


May 4, 1946: Marty Mann explained Alcoholics Anonymous and the National Committee for Education on Alcoholism on the "We the People" radio show.

May 11, 1935: From the Mayflower Hotel, Bill Wilson called Walter Tunks who referred him to Henrietta Seiberling who introduced Bill to Dr. Bob.

May 12, 1935: Bill Wilson and Dr. Bob Smith met for the first time in Akron, Ohio, at the home of Henrietta Seiberling.

May 28, 1974: The first World Service meeting of AA outside of America was held in London, UK.

1948: The AA Grapevine reported \$2.00 was sent to the General Service headquarters of AA in New York, asking for a bottle of Alcoholics Anonymous.
